
PSHE – Healthy Me

Notice changes to farms over a period of time.



Physical Development

- Hold a pencil in a tripod grip and uses it with control (see class page)
- Fine and gross motor activities
- Uses tools safely and with control e.g. scissors for cutting
- Move confidently, travelling in different ways.
- Begin to use a racket and ball tennis
- Outdoor Adventure
- Enjoy-a-Ball (Throwing, catching, kicking and striking)
- Dance

Mathematics

- Continue to develop their subitising skills for numbers within and beyond 5, and increasingly connect quantities to numerals.
- Begin to identify missing parts for numbers within 5
- Explore the structure of the numbers 6 and 7 as '5 and a bit' and connect this to finger patterns and the Hungarian number frame
- Focus on equal and unequal groups when comparing numbers
- Understand that two equal groups can be called a 'double' and connect this to finger patterns
- Sort odd and even numbers according to their 'shape'
- Continue to develop their understanding of the counting sequence and link cardinality and ordinality through the 'staircase' pattern
- Order numbers and play track games
- Join in with verbal counts beyond 20, hearing the repeated pattern within the counting numbers

<u>Understanding the World – The Natural</u> World

- Observing changes in the seasons from Winter to Spring.
- Observing plants grow.
- Planting seeds.
- Naming animals and their babies.
- Notice changes in environment farm to town
- Understanding where our food comes from.
- Draw pictures of animals from farm.
