Serious Concerns- Drop off

While we appreciate the needs of working parents no child should be left unsupervised outside the school gate before the start of school. The school gates are not open until 08:30. Before this time there are no staff on duty and children must either wait with a parent or parents can wait in their cars with their children to use the drop off system. The road outside the school is a very busy one and the school car park is accessed at all times, including 08:20-08:50am if we have visitors, meaning it is not a safe place for children to be waiting alone.

Staff and parents have raised serious concerns about the safety of children at the gate, left unsupervised on the road, which I share. Yesterday morning I opened the gate at exactly 08:30 and there were already many children waiting without an adult. Next term I will be continue to monitor this situation closely.

Children for lightning squad should be accompanied by an adult to the Willow Club door and handed over to the adult in charge.
